



The Bus Subsidy Fund

The Bus Subsidy Fund is intended to provide local travel assistance to groups of students attending the Festival's Spreading the Word events, based on financial need. The program is generously underwritten by donor Bonnie Mah.

COSTS COVERED

School groups attending the Festival can apply for a subsidy per student equivalent to single-direction transit fares required to travel to the Festival; i.e. a group of 30 students from a Burnaby school can apply for a \$82.50 subsidy (30 x \$2.75 fare). The school can use this money for transit tickets or as a contribution towards other transportation means.

HOW TO APPLY

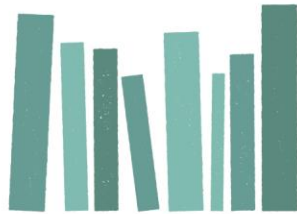
Apply by filling in the Bus Subsidy Request Form. Eligible schools are those that are economically challenged or otherwise identified as in need of support. The request for a Bus Subsidy can be made in conjunction with an application for subsidised tickets through the Cynthia Woodward Development Fund if necessary, but the program is also open to schools that are paying for tickets.

Funding is limited. If the request is approved, the teacher will be notified by email and a cheque for the subsidy will be mailed to the school as soon as the group's event tickets are fully processed and ready for pickup.
